REHABILITATION OF DISTURBED LANDSCAPE Proposed revegetation to create Open Woodland / Grassland Habitat. Patches are typically 5-10ha with distance between patches about 300m.

Proposed habitat is favourable for focal species including: Hooded Robin, Diamond Firetail, Large Eared Pied Bat, Painted Honey Eater and Regent Honey Eater.
